We're pleased to announce that Google Digital Garage will be delivering talks. Invites will be going out soon for attendees.

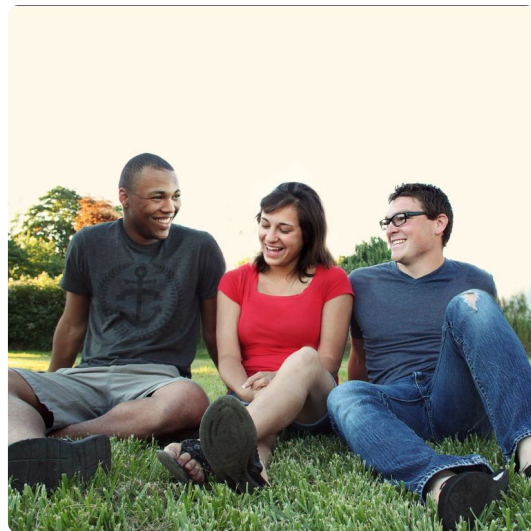

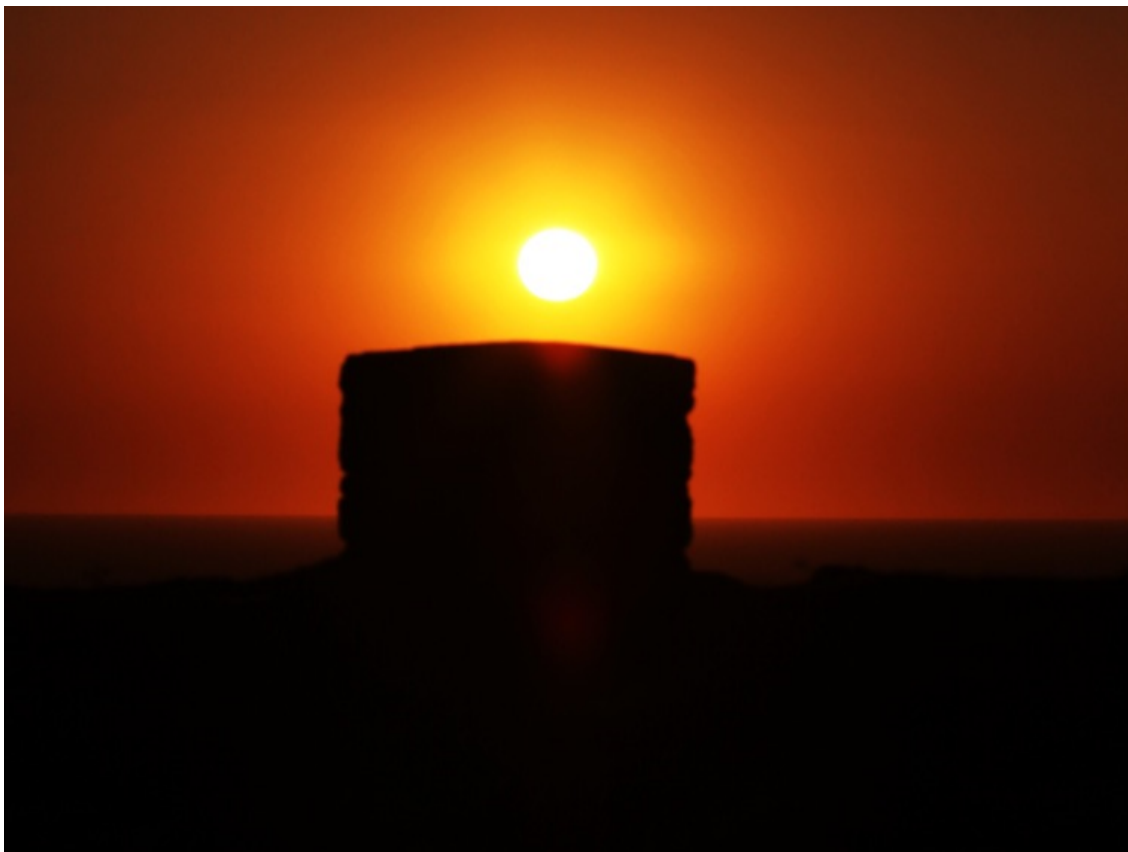

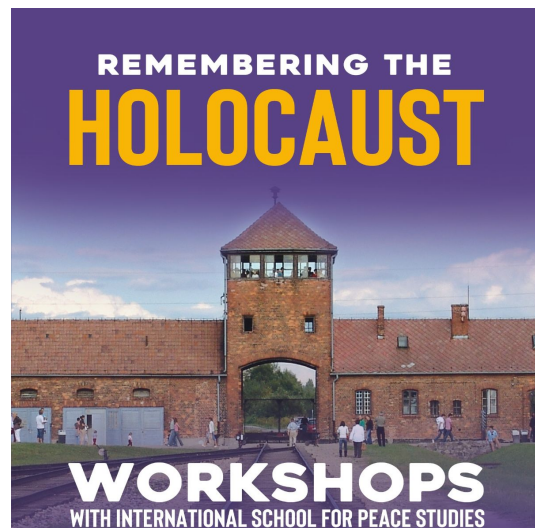
