## **Project Overview:**

The Churches Trust in Derry-Londonderry commissioned the production of a 20-minute film documenting a guided tour of the Columba Heritage Trail. The film is narrated by a local artist who provides an invaluable insight into the collaborative cross community approach to the creation of the Columba Heritage Trail and how themes of peace and reconciliation were fundamental to the development of public art pieces located along the trail. The Columba Heritage Trail promote a better understanding of a shared heritage that unites people of different traditions and values.

## **Project Impact:**

- Participants representing different faith traditions and values attended a filmed guided tour of the Columba Heritage Trail.
- The production of the film entitled 'Columba Herritage Artwork Tour' showcases collaboration between four Christian denominations on the creation of the Columba Heritage Trail.
- Enhanced the development of tourism experiences with the development of Peace Tourism products within the Derry City and Strabane District Council area.
- Production of a training tool for developing ethical tour guiding skills and undertaking Diversity and Good Relations based courses.
